Class 59 - Novice M&M/Show Pony/Hunter Type First Ridden

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128 cm. Riders not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

Class 60 - Open M&M/Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Leading Rein

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over. Not exceeding 122cms. Shown in a snaffle bit only. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January. The 2 highest placed registered Welsh Sec A and 2 Sec B ponies will qualify for the National Supreme Brynseion Stud Ridden Lead Rein Championship. The 2 highest placed registered WPBR Lead Rein ponies will qualify for the National Welsh Ridden Part Bred Lead Rein Championship.

Class 61 - Open M&M/Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony First Ridden

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over. Not exceeding 128cms. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Ridden off the Lead. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January. The 2 highest placed registered Welsh Sec A and 2 Sec B ponies will qualify for the National Supreme Brynseion Stud First Ridden Championship. The 2 highest placed registered WPBR First Ridden ponies will qualify for the National Welsh First Ridden Part Bred Championship.

Mini Championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 58 – 61 to compete.

Champion and Reserve eligible for Supreme Ridden

Novice Classes not before 9.45am

Following classes are open to Stallion, Mare or Geldings, 4 years old and over. Rider any age except for stallions – see conditions of entry. Snaffle Bridle only.

Class 62 – Just Backed Ridden Any Breed

Ridden off the Lead. Rider any age (Except Stallions – see conditions of entry). Exhibits must be in their first year under saddle. Walk and trot only, cantering in the individual show is optional. Must be in a snaffle bridle.

Class 63 – Novice Section A & B Ridden

1st and 2nd eligible for WPCS performance medal championship

Class 64 – Novice Section C & D Ridden

1st and 2nd eligible for WPCS performance medal championship

Class 65 - Novice Mountain & Moorland Ridden (excluding welsh)

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor/Exmoor/Shetland/ Novice Connemara/New Forest/Fell/Dales/Highland, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

Novice Championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners' classes 62 – 65 to compete.

(Champion and Reserve eligible for Supreme Ridden)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - Your personal data

Exhibitor you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you. Your privacy is extremely important to WPCS, so we want you to know exactly how we will use that personal information. Our full privacy notice setting out detailed information about matters such as what personal information we use, for what purpose we use it, what our legal basis for doing so is and who we share your personal information with, can be viewed on our website <http://wpcs.uk.com/> If you would prefer to see a hard copy of our privacy notice, please ask a member of WPCS staff to provide you with the same.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The Organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, accident or injury to Person, Animal or property.
2. The Judge's decision is final. All objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary, within half an hour of a class. A deposit of £25 must accompany the objection and will be forfeit if the objection is not upheld.
3. All equines in medal classes must be registered with the W.P.C.S.- except foals unless they are 6 months old.
4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes if less than three entries are received.
5. Solihull RC require 12month flu vaccinations.
6. All foals at foot must be over three weeks old. All weaned foals must be 5 months old or over.
7. Exhibitors are not allowed to show any equine under a Judge who has owned, bred, or had any financial interest in, or produced for gain, the said animal.
8. No equine can be awarded more than one medal in any year (Silver/Gold/Ridden medals excepted) If the Champion and reserve have already won medals, the medal will be withheld.
9. All trophies and cups remain the property of the Association and must be returned in good condition and in good time for the next year's show.
10. Whips and Canes No shaft of any whip or cane shall exceed 75cms (30 inches).
11. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit at the ring on time for their class, not the responsibility of the announcer.
12. A brood mare is a mare that has produced a foal, live or dead (vets certificate required) in the current year, all other mares are classed as barren.
13. Ridden Welsh Classes are run under WP&CS Rules Novices -: A Pony/Cob/Welsh Part-Bred shall be deemed to be a Novice if, by 1st January of the current year, it has not won an Open class within the discipline in which it is currently competing. All Novice ridden animals must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle
14. All Ridden Equines must be 4 years old or over.
15. Animals, 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle may be trimmed.
16. All colts/stallion 2yr and over must be bitted and lead by a handler that is 14 or over on the 1st of January in the current year
17. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear.
18. Riders of stallions 13.2hh and under must be 12 years old as of 1st January and riders of stallions over 13.2hh must be 14 years of age as of the 1st of January.
19. Entry fees will not be refunded without a Veterinary Certificate
20. If the show is cancelled all entry fees will be returned unless the show is rescheduled then no fee's will be returned.
21. The committee reserve the right to ask a competitor to leave the ring if he/she is seen to be showing cruelty or abuse to their animal.
22. No bags or other forms of noise aids are not to be used around the rings, please have respect for other competitors. Anyone who continues after the first warning will be asked to leave and any future entries will be refused.

23. Midland WPCA Privacy Statement:

Information from entry forms will be stored on a secure server and the name & address and details of entries will be published in the catalogue (if applicable). Information will be passed to our printer solely for formulating the catalogue. Results information, including photographs may be published (in printed form and online) both to the press, other societies and showing organisations and in the Association's publications (including social media). Information may be supplied to DEFRA, trading standards and veterinary advisors if requested by them. The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.
